The Southwest Washington Regional Transportation Council's (RTC) mission is, "To encourage and promote the development of a regional transportation system that efficiently maximizes the mobility of people and goods within and through the region and minimizes transportation air pollution."

RTC has facilitated regional collaboration since 1992. Led by local elected and transportation agency officials representing the region's diverse communities, RTC conducts planning and grants funding towards transportation investments which are implemented on a regional scale with a strong multi-modal emphasis.
