Seeking these specific/demonstrated skills:

- GIS: GIS mapping, spatial analysis, database development/management, cartography layout/design, and associated skills. Proficiency should be at a mid-high level, enabling the incumbent to assume a role advancing the agency's GIS and analytical programs. Incumbents can bring creativity and offer new insights and technical capacity to advance program development.

We are eager to meet individuals who are self-starters and can work seamlessly in a team environment. RTC is lean organization, and the assigned portfolio may be broad and include multiple project assignments.

Placement in the Intern assignment would comprise a work commitment ranging from 15-25 hrs/week; at an hourly rate of \$23.87 (per/hr. FSLA Non-exempt). (Position could transition into full-time permanent position as an Associate Planner, upon skills match, agency need, and mutual interest). We are working in-person / with limited hybrid (office location, Vancouver, WA).
