

Human Services Transportation Plan 2022 Update



Southwest Washington Regional Transportation Council (RTC) is working with community stakeholders on a 2022 update to the *Human Services Transportation Plan for the Clark, Skamania, and Klickitat county region*. The intent of the federally-required Human Services Transportation Plan (HSTP) is to identify the special transportation needs of people with disabilities, low income, the young and elderly, and those in rural locations who cannot provide transportation for themselves.  - Services (medical, shopping, etc.)
 - Geographical areas (neighborhoods)
 - Recreation
4. What transportation currently works for you?
 - What needs enhancement?
 - What means of transportation do you use?
